



# RINGS COMPETITION 2010



- ◆ ***Fee to enter***

The fee to enter the competition is €5. Entry procedure is as follows:

- a) Place €5 in an envelope and mark it "Rings Competition"
- b) Place the envelope in the ladies competition box with your first score card

- ◆ ***Selecting Scores***

Scores can only be returned in a qualifying competition.

Select a score or scores at a hole where a good score is returned and put a "ring" around it. A score must also be recorded in the small ring binder in the ladies locker room. Both the gross and nett score must be recorded.

e.g. a lady with a handicap of 36 has a 5 on the 5<sup>th</sup> hole i.e. a gross par. This is a good score so she should draw a ring around the score on her scorecard and record this in the ring binder in the ladies locker room. Her gross score is 5 and as her handicap is 36 and she has two shots on the 5<sup>th</sup> hole, her nett score is 3.

Scores should be recorded in this way over the course of the season so that a score is recorded for all 18 holes.

- ◆ ***Selecting a better Score***

If a better score is achieved at a later date on a hole which has been previously "ringed", the hole may be circled again. This allows two chances to "ring" a score at each hole.

- ◆ ***Winner of the Competition***

The winner at the end of the season is the person who has returned the lowest nett score over the 18 holes.
