

Winter Annual Handicap Review

Dear Member,

Since 2008 the GUI have instructed every Golf Club to incorporate new software responsible for running the Handicapping system. This software will evaluate every golfer by analysing their scoring compared to an average returned by clubs to the GUI.

If a golfer is outside the buffer zone of what the average is for his standard then the software will recommend an adjustment either up or down by up to 2.0

Last year the software recommended over 90 adjustments and the Handicap committee agreed with over 70 of these and added a recommendation of our own which the GUI accepted.

This year the committee will publish the agreed adjustments with the GUI. These adjustments will be on a player's official GUI handicap and will come into effect as soon as the recommendations have been accepted.
